- Show how Walt Whitman's 'Passage to India' celebrates a pre-established connection between the East of spiritual quest and the West of scientific progress.
  - Is the poem 'Prologue' a critique of the patriarchal set-up in American Literature?
  - "The four rivers that Langston Hughes mentions are not just random names, they form the core of the Negro identity."— Discuss.
  - How does Sherman Alexie use the symbol of the 'crow' to narrate the history of abuse and forceful assimilation of the native Americans in the poem 'Crow Testament'?

Critically evaluate the theme of exploitation as projected in the poem 'Evolution'.

2. Answer any *one* of the following question in about 500 words: 15×1 = 15
- Show how Toni Morrison uses two historic times as well as two locales simultaneously as the setting of the novel 'Beloved'.

- Write a detailed note on the female characters in the novel 'Beloved'.
3. Answer any *one* short question from the following in about 200 words: 5×1 = 5
- 'The Purloined Letter' recommends the approach of a combined poet and mathematician. Elaborate.
  - What types of autobiographical elements can one find in the essays entitled 'The Crack-up'?
  - What happens to the character of Will Mayes in the short story 'Dry September'?
  - Illustrate the use of nature imagery in the short story 'Ambitious Guest'.
